Who is eligible for the SEASONAL INFLUENZA and H1N1 vaccine?

- Anyone 6 months of age and older
- In order for a child (17 years and younger) to receive the seasonal or H1N1 vaccine a parent or guardian must be present to authorize vaccination for the child. If someone other than a parent or guardian is bringing the child written consent from the parent or guardian is required.

The charge for a SEASONAL FLU shot is:

- \$25 (may pay with either cash or check), or
- Medicaid (have to have a physician's order and must bring your Medicaid card), or
- Medicare part B (must bring your card).

The H1N1 flu shots are FREE of charge.
